



## USA WORKING EQUITATION

### Scribe Duties



- Organize the work area for yourself and the Judge: pens, tests, Order of Go, bell or whistle.
- Quickly, accurately, legibly, and quietly record the scores and comments made about each ride by the Judge.
- Recognize that what is said at the Judge's table is between the Judge and the rider.
- Do not volunteer information about competitors or their horses.
- Wait for the Judge to initiate conversation between rides or while on break.
- Remain focused on scribing to accurately record the comments and scores.
- Record only what the Judge says, and do not edit, add, or delete any comments.
- Record the score with either a .5 or .0 at the end of each mark (e.g., 5.0; 5.5),
