CHAIR APPOINTMENT - COMPETITIONS COMMITTEE – requested by Jeanne Bond, Chair

Rationale: Competitions Chair Jeanne Bond resigned 5/15/2023; fill the Competitions Chair vacancy.

EXCEPTION FOR LOC SEMINAR ATTENDEES IN COMPETITIONS – requested by LOC Co-Chair Christy Reich

Rationale: The Licensed Officials Committee (LOC) puts on large, in-person seminars at least once a year. The seminars are held jointly with licensed shows to give the candidates a chance to apply their skills in real time with the instructors present. Some attendees choose to attend both the classroom sessions and compete in the show, as evidenced by classroom attendants who also competed last year at the LOC seminars at Bulls Gap, Tennessee and Thousand Oaks, California.

In 2023, the U.S. Rules for Working Equitation, Rev 6.1, section 3.20b, was modified as follows:

The following individuals may not compete under a Judge:

A trainer, coach, or student of a Judge within the 30-day period prior to a competition. This includes clinics or providing assistance in group activities, as well as private instruction. *Exception:* Clinics may be offered prior to a competition to competitors who have not competed above Level 1; auditing is not restricted. Schooling shows prior to a licensed competition are acceptable. Clinics, group sessions, or private instruction are permitted after a competition.

This ruling was not intended to exclude LOC seminars; however, the wording could be interpreted by some as not allowing seminar classroom participants to compete in the associated show and may draw a protest. This, however, is an educational event separate from a standard clinic or private riding lesson and open to all members who wish to attend. The LOC requests that a special exception be given to this ruling to differentiate a LOC produced classroom seminar from a clinic or lesson situation that "provides assistance in group activities or private instruction.
