Google Forms offers show organizers a way to capture show entries online and download to an excel file.

Using FREE <u>Google Forms</u> to capture registrations can save you hours of work in processing show entries. Simply create (or copy a previously used Google Forms - WE Online Show Entry Form)

- provide the link to show participants (via an email or social media event invite)
- ask each rider to complete the online show entry
- then review show entries in real-time and download it as an excel file

Google Forms creates an excel spreadsheet that can be shared amongst show management, use captured competitor email addresses to send show announcements and course maps and use horse-rider pair data to create your ride order/start lists (manual or GIRA).

No refund unless you are unable to attend due to a true medical or horse emergency (COVID exposure, sickness, medically unsound to ride) of which a physician/veterinarian note is required; entry fees (less \$50 processing fee) for medical emergencies will be refunded.

Full refund with physician/veterinarian note (less \$50 processing fee) if you are unable to attend due to a true medical or horse emergency (COVID exposure, sickness, medically unsound to ride). Otherwise, entry fees (less \$50 processing fee) can be applied to another competition hosted by Name.

In the event of the cancellation of the entire competition, entry fees will be returned minus the \$50 non-refundable processing fee.

Competition Refund - A Horse-Rider pair that withdrawals before the entry closing date will receive a full refund minus the \$50 non-refundable processing fee. Withdrawals received after the entry closing date are non-refundable.

A withdrawal due to rider or horse injury, illness or death after the entry closing date of the competition must be accompanied by a veterinarian's or doctor's certificate and will be handled on a case-by-case basis by the competition management. If your entry is able to be filled, you may receive a full refund minus a \$50 non-refundable processing fee. If competition management is unable to replace your entry, no refund will be given.

ALL withdrawals must be received (in writing or email) by the show secretary no later than the specified withdrawal deadline and must be accompanied by a veterinarian's or doctor's certificate to obtain any refund.

Once a refund has been confirmed by the competition management, please allow 14 days for your money to be refunded.


