

# MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered in January 2022 between World Association Working Equitation, ("WAWE"), with registered office in Av. Mem Ramires, no 94 | S. ## WHEREAS:

- (a) WAWE is recognized by its members as the sole international authority in what concerns working equitation and comprises the entities responsible for the organization of working equitation in different current or future country members;
- (b) WAWE is statutorily bound to pursue the recognition of working equitation as an official discipline by the international Equestrian Federation ("FEI");
- (c) WAWE recognizes the FEI as the sole and exclusive entity with the authority to regulate and organize the traditional equestrian disciplines of equitation and its corresponding competitions;
- (d) WAWE is bound to foster the development of working equitation, divulging and promoting general working equitation principles, always safeguarding the differences (type of mount, harness and dress) existing in the different countries, never preventing the entry of new countries, even those which in spite of not having a tradition of horse work in the field, wish to comply with its articles of association, general regulations and private articles;



(e) WAWE is bound to foster the development of working equitation, divuiging and promoting general working equitation principles, always safeguarding the differences (type of mount, harness and dress) existing in the different countries, never preventing the entry of new countries, even those which in spite of not having a tradition of horse work in the field, wish to comply with its articles of association, general regulations and private articles; ) duplicate

- (f) WAWE may provisionally accept the membership of a national organization other than a national federation provided that no entity from the country in question is already a member, pursuant to which the referred organization enjoys the same rights given to a national federation within the WAWE and consequently its recognition;
- (g) USAWE USA Working Equitation is the culmination of many years' effort on the part of Working Equitation advocates and several organizations.
- (h) IN 2020 the two active and predominant WE organizations in the United States, WE United and the Confederation for Working Equitation, agreed to merge into one association to best serve the sport and competitors in the United States of America and represents the Interests of most riders, judges, trainers and other stakeholders in USA.
- (i) USAWE expressly recognizes WAWE as the sole only international organization responsible for working equitation worldwide and further declares to abide and apply all the regulations currently in force as well as the future regulations emanated by WAWE.
- (j) WAWE acknowledges the second party's potential to foster the development and recognition of working equitation in USA and wishes to provide its assistance and support to pursue such goals.



NOW therefore it is hereby agreed as follows:

#### Clause 1

WAWE appoints the second party as Official Accredited Agent for the promotion of working equitation in USA as off February 2022 and for the period of 3 (three years), until January 2025. On termination date parties agree on a renewal of the present MOU for equal of different periods.

#### Clause 2

As Official Accredited Agent of WAWE in USA, the second party agrees to:

- (a) Submit all the current used regulations to be verified by WAWE to verify whether the Regulations currently in place are in accordance with the WAWE rules and principles.
- (b) Submit all the current education system for working equitation officials, as well as a complete list of the current authorized officials, to be verified by WAWE.
- (c) Organize and promote, at least, 2 (two) official Zone Championships working equitation competitions in its country according to WAWE's practices, standards, rules and regulations, attended and verified by at least 1 (one) WAWE official.
- (d) Unconditionally abide by and apply WAWE's general and internal regulations, refraining itself from the use of any other regulation.
- (e) Render the necessary publicity to the Regulations in force as of the date of the signature, namely publish them in the respective website.
- (f) Promote the participation of officials in the WAWE organized formation courses
- (g) Inform WAWE of the yearly activities as well as all revelant international results obtained by its national athletes.



#### Clause 3

As Official Accredited Agent of WAWE in USA, the second party is entitled to:

- (a) Use the designation of exclusive Official Accredited Agent of WAWE in *USA* for the Effective Period;
- (b) Exclusively appoint a national team and individual competitors to attend European and World official championships organized by WAWE;
- (c) Appoint national judges for promotion purposes
- (d) Receive WAWE's full support and assistance in all matters deemed necessary

### Clause 4

In the event of any breach by the second party to any of its obligations under this MOU, which is not remedied within 30 days from notice given by WAWE, this MOU may be unilaterally terminated by WAWE.
