975 Recipients | 120 responses; 4 duplicates, leaving 116 individual responses.

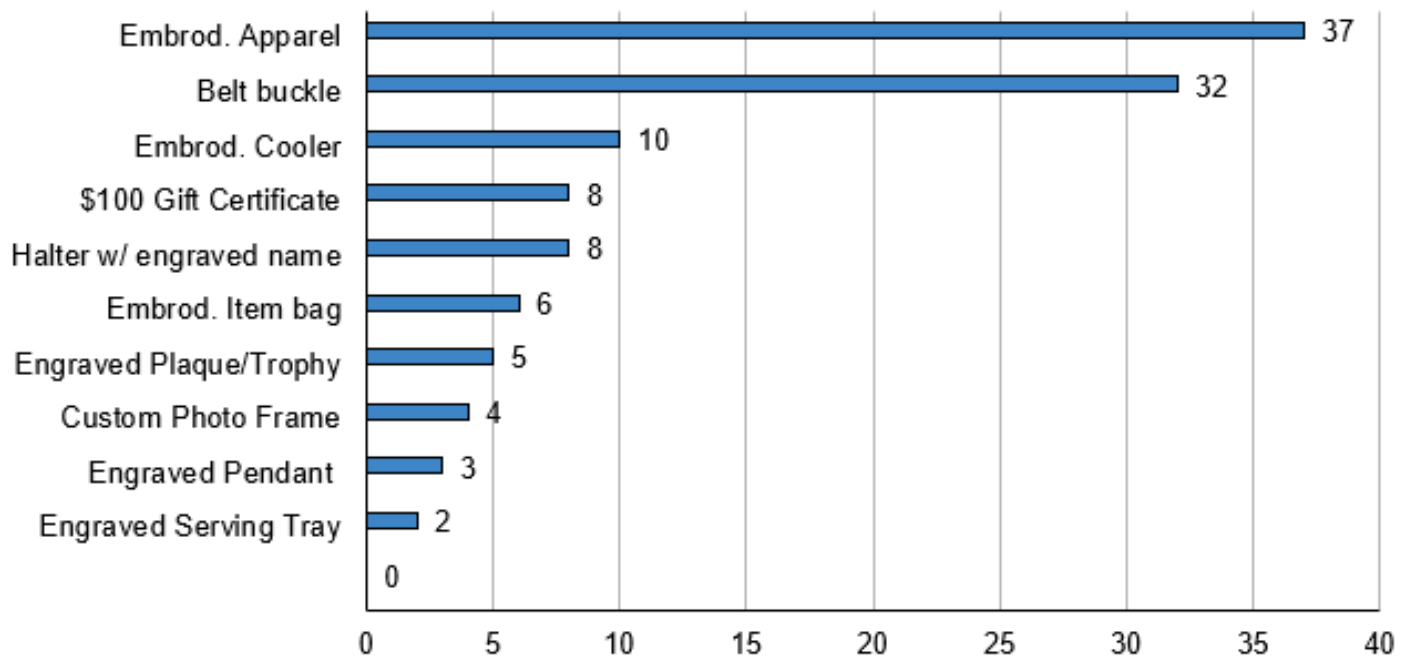

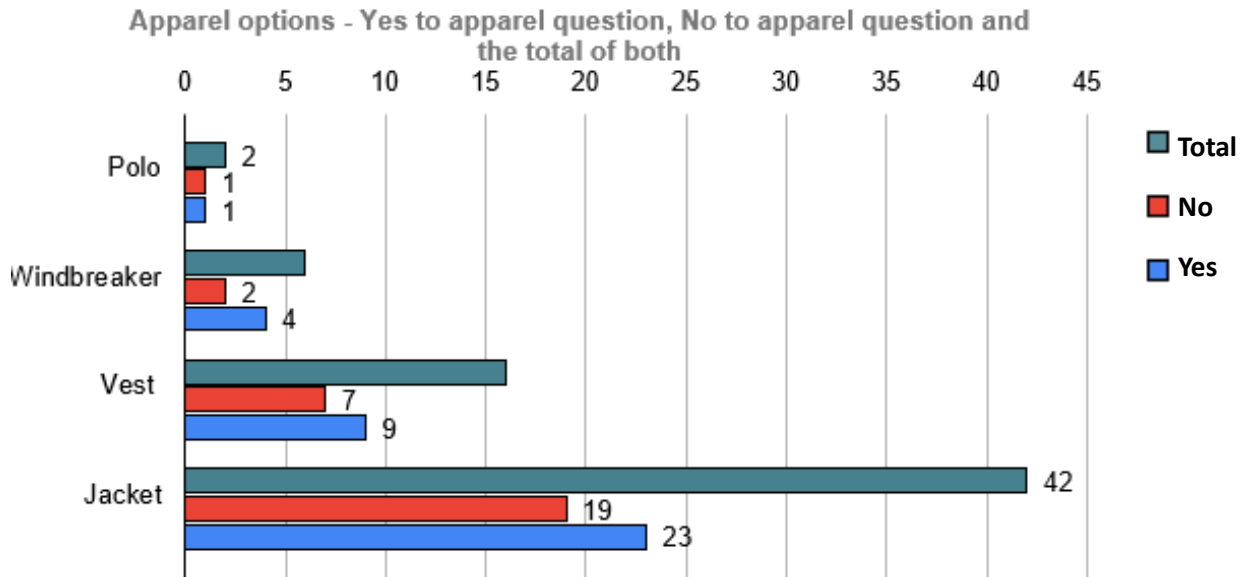

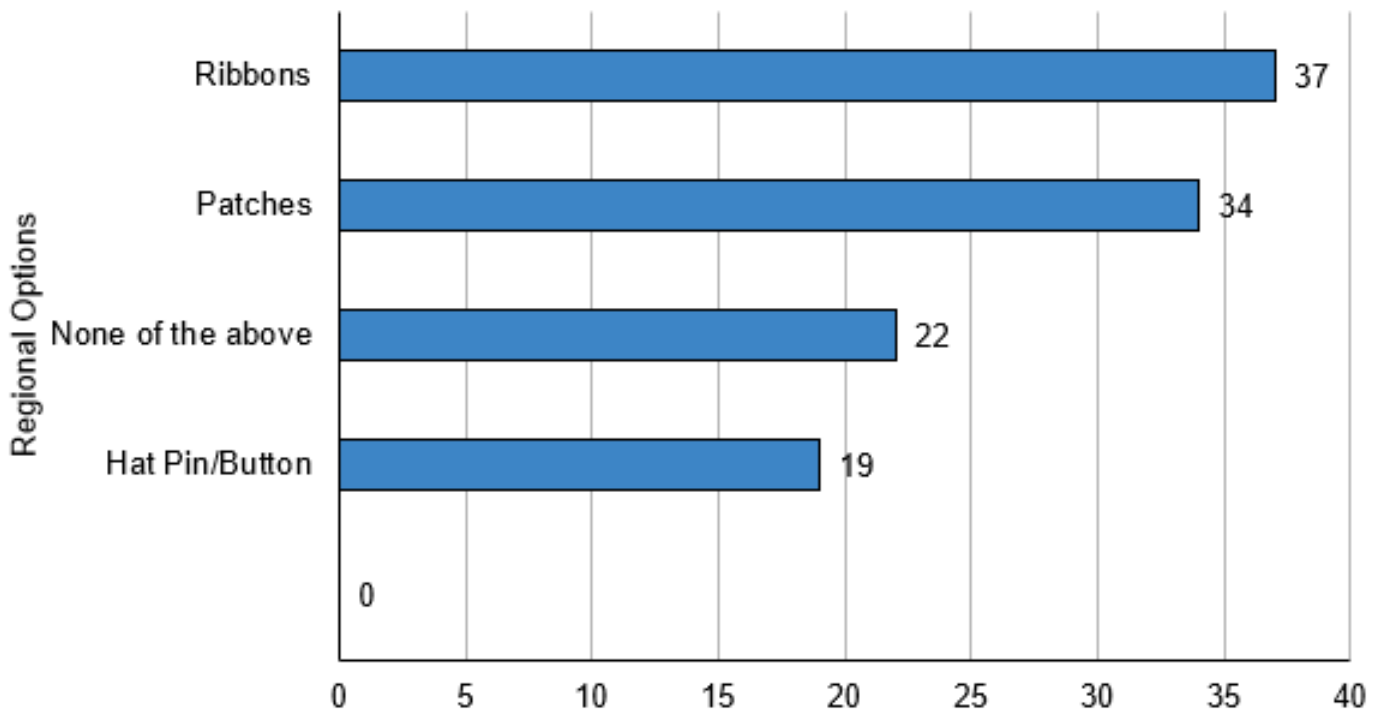
