Members of the Board (sent upon request of Rules Committee Chair, Secretary and President),

The Rules committee has determined it necessary to issue a 1-page revision to the Rulebook to clarify a statement related to the Jump obstacle in Appendix B. The change clarifies that a break in gait over the obstacle will result in a lower mark only for L1 competitors, as well as provides guidance on scoring the gait options for that level. This problem was brought to our attention by several judges who were unclear on the intent of the rule based on the wording in Rev 7.1.

The change in wording is highlighted in yellow in the attached document (the text in red was what was issued for 7.1). We ask that you please vote to approve this change quickly so we can get it released as soon as possible. If you have any questions about this, please ask Jeanne Bond, Rules Chair cc'd on this eVote Request.

#### I am withholding my vote until there is more of an explanation.

I know how hard the rules committee works on this document, however....

IMHO, penalizing a horse for cantering away from a jump goes against everything in my knowledge of dressage training and what would be required in field work.

The jump itself is a canter stride. So it is unclear to me how we expect them to have perfected the art of taking one canter stride over the jump at L1, because the execution requires a "jump ... with assurance", not a jump expecting to trot immediately.

So what this rule is saying is that we are requiring L1 horses to trot over the rail, not jump. Yet in the "execution" it clearly says "jump".

Jeanne, would you please explain the thinking behind this rule before I vote? Thank you so much, /t
