Competition Requirements

Eastern Zone Championship Show

Only USAWE current members are eligible to compete in a championship show. A horse-rider combination must earn a combined average of 58% or higher in Dressage and EOH (L1-L7) and successfully complete the Speed trial (L2-L7) at a minimum of two licensed shows.

For the 2024 competition year, the qualifying period is January 1, 2023 through the show entry deadline in 2024. At least one of the scores must be earned during the current competition year.

WE Show at Three Bulls

All competitors must hold a current membership with USAWE.

All competing horses must be recorded with USAWE in advance of the show. A one-time fee of \$30 per horse includes lifetime performance tracking.

Riders with disabilities can apply for a Dispensation Certificate that approves the use of adaptive equipment and other allowances. The certificate must be approved prior to the competition and a copy submitted with the entry form.

Eastern Zone Cattle Trial

The Cattle Trial is optional and open to Championship Show L2-L7 competitors first. If the trial does not fill, WE Show at Three Bulls L2-L7 competitors will be given the opportunity to enter.



Prizes/Awards

- Championship and Reserve Championship rosettes, prizes, and monies will be awarded to the overall first and second place Horse-Rider teams in each level/division.
- Rosettes are awarded from 1st thru 5th place for all divisions in each level.
- Several breed-specific awards will be offered. They will be determined by the highest average Dressage/EOH score from all levels/divisions for that breed. The list of breeds sponsored will be announced after the close of entries.

Entry Procedures

• A separate entry form must be completed for each Horse-Rider combination **for each show**. The online forms may be found below.

- For the Championship Show, competitors must list their qualifying scores on their entry form.
- If you are unable to submit the forms electronically, the hard copies are included with this prize list. Please mail the forms to the Show Secretary along with a check made payable to <u>Working Equitation East</u>.
- An entry form is not valid unless it is fully completed and has all the **proper signatures**, **membership numbers**, and **horse information**. Each entry form must have the original signatures (not copies) of Riders/Handlers and Owner/Agent. An adult must sign for any youth rider.
- Entries must be received by the closing date. Entries received after the closing date will be assessed a **\$50** late fee. Late entries will be placed on a waiting list and included in the schedule, if possible.
- No phone entries will be accepted.
- Entries are accepted on a first-paid, first-served basis.
- Photocopy of a negative **Coggins** test, dated no earlier than October 6, 2023, is required and <u>must be</u> <u>presented at the time of check-in</u> for online entries or mailed with the hard copy entry forms. Entries without a current (valid through show date) negative **Coggins** test result will not be allowed to show or remain on the premises.
- Any **non-competing horses** must have an entry form and negative Coggins test submitted by mail or electronically.
- Tennessee State law requires a current health certificate for horses arriving from out of state.

- Mailed Entry and Stabling forms A check made payable to <u>Working Equitation East</u> for the total due must accompany the forms.
- No entry may show unless it is paid in full.

Refunds

• **Full Refunds** minus the office fee will be issued for cancelations prior to closing date. After closing date, refunds will be granted with a note from physician or veterinarian and at the sole discretion of show management.



Stabling Details

- Tennessee State law requires a current **health certificate** for horses arriving from out of state. Your horse cannot be stabled on the grounds without a health certificate or a current negative Coggins test.
- Three Bulls LLC has 12 x 12 box stalls, all with individual fans installed. There are a limited number of small pens with shelters that will be offered on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Competitors may show out of their trailer. There will be a \$50 charge (for the weekend).
- Arrival: Wednesday, October 3, 2024, starting at 9:00 a.m.
- **Departure:** Monday, October 7, 2024, by 11:00 a.m.
- Early arrivals/late departures must be coordinated with and approved by the Stable Manager and will be subject to an additional \$50 charge per stall/pen per day.
- Emergency contact information must be prominently displayed on all stalls housing an animal, including both cell phone and local contact information.
- Stalls include initial shavings. Additional shavings may be purchased for \$8/bag.

Tack Stalls

• Tack stalls will be offered at \$30/night, **if available**, after close of entries on a first-come, first-served basis. We encourage sharing tack stalls.

General Information

- All shows will be conducted and judged in accordance with the <u>United States Rules for Working</u> <u>Equitation</u>, Revision 7.2, dated 20 March 2024. The rules may be found at the following site: <u>https://usawe.org/competitions/rules/</u>
- It is the competitor's responsibility to read and understand the rules prior to the competition.
- Riders must be correctly attired and horses properly presented in accordance with the <u>U.S. Rules for Working</u> <u>Equitation</u>. Show Management may, at its discretion, bar any person or horse from entering the arena if not suitably presented.
- A rider must compete in the division designated on their USAWE membership application, i.e., Youth, Amateur, or Open. See <u>U.S. Rules for Working Equitation</u>, Appendix G, for details.
- Three Bulls reserves the right to refuse an entry for any reason.
- Three Bulls LLC and Working Equitation East reserve the right to maintain a Harassment Free Environment and may remove or refuse entry to any person(s) disrupting the show.

- Hold Harmless Clause: Understanding that horse sports may be hazardous and dangerous, even leading to permanent injury or death, each owner, rider, spectator, and other participant assumes any and all risk of loss or injury and agrees to hold harmless, regardless, the horse show personnel and the facility hosting the show. Three Bulls, LLC and Working Equitation East will not be responsible for any damage, injury, or loss to persons, horses, or property of exhibitors, spectators, or grooms. All local facility rules must be followed.
- **Motor Vehicle Operation:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
- Media Release Agreement: The Competition reserves the right to use or assign photographs and videos of competitors taken during the course of the competition for the promotion or benefit of the sport. No photos or videos will be used to advertise a product nor used in any way to jeopardize amateur status. The competitor waives/releases any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or misappropriation.

Facility Requirements

- No smoking is allowed in any barns or buildings.
- Drive carefully. Watch for children and pets.
- No loose dogs/pets are allowed anywhere on the premises. All dogs that are not crated must be on a leash or in a stall. Clean up after dog/pet. No dogs are allowed in the indoor arena except for service dogs.
- No overnight horses may be stabled in trailers or tied out.
- No vehicles are allowed in the barns.
- No gray water may be dumped on the ground.
- No campfires are permitted.
- Camp sites must be kept clean, and campers must dispose of any trash in receptacles provided. All campers are responsible for leaving their campsite as they found it. Any damage or repairs resulting from negligence shall be the responsibility of the camper.
- Fireworks are prohibited.
- Three Bulls reserves the right to remove any camper or visitor who is in violation of these rules and regulations.
- Three Bulls shall be held harmless against all claims, costs, losses or liability of every nature and kind asserted against or incurred by campers.

By entering a USAWE-licensed competition and signing this entry form as the Owner, Rider, or Parent/Guardian, I agree that I am subject to and agree to be bound by the Bylaws of USAWE applicable to the USAWE-licensed competition, the <u>U.S. Rules for Working Equitation</u> ("Rules"), and the requirements of the competition as stated in the Prize List. I will accept as final the decision of the Protests Committee or Appeals Committee on any question arising under the Rules and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, USAWE, their officials, officers, directors, employee, agents, personnel, volunteers, and USAWE affiliates for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I understand and agree that copies of scoresheets may be retained for Licensed Officials Committee judge training purposes only.

In consideration for my participation in this Competition, I AGREE to the following:
